Supply List

Clothes:	You will be staying for three weeks and will have the opportunity to do laundry while here. New England weather, even in summer, can vary quite a lot. With this in mind, please pack the following items:	
	3-4 pairs of pants	This should be casual or sweat pants. Many activities take place outside and clothes may get soiled.
	5 + short sleeved shirts	You will participate in many invigorating activities – you will perspire, cool shirts are a must.
	5+ pairs of shorts	You will participate in many invigorating activities – you will perspire, cool shorts are a must.
	Sleep wear	Something cool, yet modest, to sleep in.
	Under garments/socks	At least enough for one week. They can be washed on weekends.
	1 or 2 nicer outfits	Nothing very fancy, just what you would wear to go shopping or eat at a restaurant.
	Bathing suit/ towel	Boys: Swim trunks (not Speedos); Girls: One pieces (no bikinis)
	Light jackets/ sweatshirts	The nights and mornings may be chilly. A light jacket or sweatshirt will keep you warm.
	Rain jacket/ umbrella	Yes, it rains here too.
	Comfortable shoes	Bring sneakers, sandals and comfortable walking shoes. We will visit many places and do a lot of walking.
Other items:	Camera/ backpack	To take pictures and carry souvenirs
	Toiletries	Tooth brush, tooth paste, soap, razor, deodorant, combs, brushes, makeup, monthly hygiene supplies
	School supplies	Pens/pencils, notebook(s), erasers, ruler, three ring binder, highlighters
Shopping:	Money	Most major stores can process your international credit cards. If you choose to bring cash, it is your responsibility to keep it safe. \$100 bills are hard to use in America. Many stores will not take them. Bring \$50 bills or smaller for ease of use.
